The relevant log4j 2.x files are found on the DocCompliance SOLr server and the ProcessCompliance server.

Search for log4j-core-2\*.jar make a note of the locations.

For DocCompliance SOLR servers stop the Solr8 service (Solr 8 for DocCompliance)

For ProcessCompliance servers Stop the ProcessCompliance service (QUMAS ProcessCompliance (Build ...))

Navigate to path of each of the files found.

Find the files corresponding to the version number in the version number contained in the core file name returned e.g. *log4j-core*-2.11.2.jar following name formats

log4j-1.2-api-2.**#.#**.jar log4j-api-2.**#.#**.jar log4j-core-2.**#.#**.jar log4j-slf4j-impl-2.**#.#**.jar log4j-web-2.**#.#**.jar

Remove them from the folder

Copy the following files (after downloading here) in to the folder .

log4j-1.2-api-2.16.0.jar

log4j-api-2.16.0.jar

log4j-core-2.16.0.jar

log4j-slf4j-impl-2.16.0.jar

log4j-web-2.16.0.jar

For DocCompliance SOLR servers start the Solr8 service (Solr 8 for DocCompliance)

For ProcessCompliance servers Start the ProcessCompliance service (QUMAS ProcessCompliance (Build ...))
